



**Commitment to the No Gift Policy of Lum Khao Subdistrict Administrative Organization
Integrity and Transparency in Lum Khao Subdistrict Administrative Organization 2026
Refraining from Accepting or Offering Any Gifts or Benefits Related to Official Duties
(No Gift Policy)**

I, Mr. Taweesak Khoking Mayor of Lum Khao Subdistrict Administrative Organization hereby declare that Lum Khao Subdistrict Administrative Organization strictly upholds the “No Gift Policy.” In accordance with the Regulation of the Office of the Prime Minister on the Giving or Receiving of Gifts by State Officials B.E. 2568 (2025), all officials and personnel shall refrain from accepting or offering any gifts, favors, or benefits related to official duties, whether before, during, or after the performance of such duties.

This policy applies to all personnel of Lum Khao Subdistrict Administrative Organization and reflects our commitment to upholding the nation’s core institutions: the Nation, Religion, the Monarchy, and the constitutional monarchy. Officials are required to uphold morality, ethical conduct, and integrity, prioritize the public interest over personal gain, and perform their duties with efficiency, fairness, and humility in accordance with the principles of good governance, including transparency, integrity, and accountability.

Accordingly, all officials of Lum Khao Subdistrict Administrative Organization shall strictly comply with the following measures:

1. The acceptance or offering of bribes, gifts, or any form of benefit in connection with official duties is strictly prohibited.
2. Officials shall not allow family members or associates to accept or offer any bribes, gifts, or benefits on their behalf in connection with official duties.
3. Officials shall perform their duties solely for the benefit of the public, avoid conflicts of interest, and refrain from actions for personal gain, while safeguarding the organization’s credibility and reputation.
4. Any acceptance or offering of gifts or benefits shall only be permitted in strict compliance with the regulations of the Office of the National Anti-Corruption Commission.
5. A zero-tolerance policy shall be maintained toward all acts of bribery or misconduct related to official duties.

This announcement shall take effect and be applicable to all concerned.
